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A Sip of Southeastern Arizona Wine Country



Prior to the early 1970s, few people would have guessed that wine grapes could be grown successfully in this region. But Gordon Dutt, a retired soil scientist from the University of Arizona, proved it could be done. Dutt experimented with growing wine grapes near Elgin in 1973. He showed that the area's soil and climate were right for growing wine grapes, and went on to found Sonoita Vine yards, Arizona's oldest commercial vineyard, in 1979.

Over the years, vineyards have been established across northeastern Santa Cruz County. All of them welcome visitors to their tasting rooms, and wine lovers should plan on spend ing the better part of a day, or even a weekend, to tour them.

Many of the local wineries sell only at their tasting room. Others have limited distribution in Arizona. Check each win ery's website for location and a listing of wines available.

AZ Hops and Vines Winery is a cheeky little winery in Southern Arizona whose mission is to bring the best wines to nice people, to cre ate the nicest place to hang out in the Southwest, and have a great time doing it! This family farm is a fun, warm place for families and wine aficionados alike. Autumn Sage Vineyards has acres of 8,300 Sagrantino, Albariño, Counoise, Cabernet Franc, Aglianico, and Sangio vese grape vines. The Tasting Room offers a unique tasting experience. Situated next to the vineyard, it has comfortable handicap accessible indoor and outdoor seating. Elgin Winery and Distillery specializes in making wines from grapes grown in Arizona and has been producing wines since the post-prohibition resurgence in winemaking in the Sonoran Desert. It also is now home to an awarded distillery.

Los Milics Vineyards is the new kid in town. Pavle Milic and his wife, Carla, co-own this 20-acre property on Mustang Mountains, 12 of which are planted. The Meading Room is operated by a mother/daughter duo who realized that Sonoita, full of wineries, brewer ies, and distilleries, was missing one thing (well, actually three): mead, cider and fruit wine. They bought the Sonoita property in 2015, and slowly began the transformation from grasslands to farm. Mead, in case you were wondering, is one of the oldest alcoholic beverages and one of the tastiest. Rossa Vineyards produces about 1,200 cases of wine each year from its 22-acre vineyard near Elgin. It spe cializes in ultra-premium dry varietal wines. The first vines were planted in 2002.

Rune Wines is a solarpowered winery with an outdoor tasting room with beautiful 360-degree views of the sur rounding mountains. Winemaker and owner James Calla han per-
